 - Roll No. 11 to 20:- Linear equations in one variable
 - Roll No. 21 to 30:- Understanding Quadrilateral
 - Roll No. 31 and above:- Practical Geometry and Data Handling
- Do the given assignment in the register.

SCIENCE

- Create a small compost pit at home using kitchen waste (vegetables peels, fruit scraps).
 - Observe and record the decomposition process over (2-3) weeks.
 - Write a report on A-4 size sheet on how compost benefits soil fertility.
- Prepare a 4-6 panel comic strip explaining the concepts like crop rotation, mixed cropping, nitrogen cycle. Use simple drawings and dialogues to make it engaging .Make it fun and educational, explaining a scientific concept through story.
- "Science in action – watch it come alive!" Prepare a working "Model" on the topics given below (according to Roll no)
 - Roll No. 1 to 10:- Resource Management
 - Roll No. 11 to 20:- Natural Farming
 - Roll No. 21 to 30:- Food and Technology

- Roll No. 31 and above:- Waste management

5. For one day, keep a diary of activities in your home that use coal or petroleum products (e.g.:- cooking with LPG, using electricity).
