<u>Science</u>

1. Make a Model of an Ideal House

Task: Make a model of an ideal house using materials like a shoe box, matchsticks, cardboard, colored paper, etc.

Creative Idea:

- Step 1: Create a 3D house using a shoe box as the base and add walls with cardboard.
- Step 2: Use matchsticks to build a fence, windows, or a roof, and colored paper to decorate
 the walls.
- Step 3: Add a mini garden with paper flowers or small toy furniture to show how the house looks inside.

- Step 4: Decorate with little personal touches like a nameplate for the house (e.g., "The Dream House").
- Add fun details like miniature trees, cars, or pets using craft supplies to bring the house to life!

2. Sense Organs Chart

Task: Make a colorful chart showing the five sense organs—**eyes, ears, nose, tongue, and skin**. Paste or draw pictures and write what each sense does (e.g., Eyes – see, Nose – smell).

Creative Idea:

- Step 1: Draw or paste cute, colorful images of each sense organ.

- Arrange the organs in a fun pattern (like in the shape of a human face or a circle).
